

SCRIPTURAL FOUNDATION

- i. **The Great Commission** – Matthew 28:18–20
Jesus commanded us to go into all the world, making disciples of all nations. Salvation Run is a Scriptural mobilization of this command taking the Gospel beyond pulpits into communities, streets, cities, towns, and nations
- ii. **The Race of Faith** – Hebrews 12:1–2 We are surrounded by a great cloud of witnesses. We run, laying aside sin and distractions, with our eyes fixed on Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith.
- iii. **Unity in the Body of Christ** – John 17:21–23
Jesus prayed that we would be one, just as He and the Father are one. Salvation Run is a response to that prayer bringing oneness to a divided world.
- iv. **The Ministry of Reconciliation** – 2 Corinthians 5:18–20 Every believer is an ambassador of Christ, carrying the message of reconciliation. This is not just a mission for clergy, but for the whole Church, lay, clergy, youth, elderly all running together in purpose.
- v. **End-Time Harvest** – Joel 2:28–32, Acts 2:17 In the last days, God will pour out His Spirit on all flesh. Sons and daughters shall prophesy. Salvation Run is a prophetic act preparing the bride of Christ and igniting revival in the earth.

THE ULTIMATE GOAL: “I will lift up the cup of SALVATION and call on the name of the lord, I will fulfill my vows to the Lord in the presence of all his people Psalm 116: And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in all the world as a witness to all the nations, and then the end will come.” Matthew 24:14


Through this divine mobilization, we are committed to:

THEMATIC FOUNDATION OF SALVATION RUN-Built on the Word. Driven by the Spirit. Focused on Christ.

- i. **ENDURANCE & PURPOSEFUL RUNNING** (Theme Verse): "Let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith." Hebrews 12:1-2 **(Supporting Verses)**: "Do you not know that in a race all the runners run, but only one receives the prize? So run that you may obtain it." 1 Corinthians 9:24 "Those who wait on the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall run and not be weary." Isaiah 40:31
- ii. **EVANGELISM & MISSION TO THE UNREACHED** (Theme Verse:) How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news Romans 10:15 **(Supporting Verses)**: Go therefore and make disciples of all nations Matthew 28:19. "Preach the word; be ready in season and out of season." 2 Timothy 4:2 The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few." Luke 10:2
- iii. **UNITY IN THE BODY OF CHRIST** (Theme Verse) "That they all may be one so that the world may believe that You sent Me." John 17:21 **(Supporting Verses)**: There is one body and one Spirit one Lord, one faith, one baptism. Ephesians 4:4-6, Now you are the body of Christ, and each one of you is a part of it. 1 Corinthians 12:27, Be perfectly united in mind and thought. 1 Corinthians 1:10
- iv. **HEALING & RESTORATION** (Theme Verse) The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted Luke 4:18

(Supporting Verses): He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds." Psalm 147:3, Come to Me, all who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Matthew 11:28 For I will restore health to you and heal you of your wounds, says the Lord." Jeremiah 30:17

- v. **TRANSFORMATION & NATION BUILDING**
(Theme Verse) "If My people who are called by My name will humble themselves and pray... then I will hear from heaven and heal their land. 2 Chronicles 7:14 **(Supporting Verses):** Do not be conformed to this world but be transformed by the renewing of your mind." Romans 12:2, "Righteousness exalts a nation Proverbs 14:34, Ask of Me, and I will give You the nations for Your inheritance. Psalm 2:8

- Proclaiming the Gospel not only in words but through creative, practical expressions: Sports, Media, Education, Arts, conferences, and Culture.
- Engaging in Marketplace Ministry, transforming workplaces, schools, digital platforms, and secular spaces into mission fields.
- Living the message of Christ daily in action and integrity.

DISCIPLESHIP FOR DESTINY Establishing Discipleship Hubs focused on youth, new believers, and future leaders. Cultivating biblical values, spiritual maturity, leadership, and purpose-driven living. Guiding every believer into their God-ordained destiny through Christ-centered mentorship and teaching

GLOBAL PRAYER & INTERCESSION Pray without ceasing.¹ Thessalonians 5:17 Watch and pray Matthew 26:41

- Mobilizing 24/7 global prayer chains, interceding for revival, nations, and the end-time harvest.
- Organizing prophetic prayer runs, Marathons, regional boot camps, and prayer summits to release spiritual awakening.
- Building a worldwide altar of continuous worship and warfare

SOCIAL REFORMATION The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me; He has anointed Me to preach good news to the poor.. to set the oppressed free Luke 4:18

- Confronting societal evils with Christ-centered solutions, Addressing injustice, poverty, addiction, abuse, broken families, and godlessness.
- Partnering with Christian congregations, NGOs, missions, hospitals, and justice movements to bring tangible transformation. Raising believers to be salt and light in every sphere from slums to parliaments.



IV. STRATEGIC ACTIVITIES OF SALVATION RUN

our core activities will serve as the practical expressions of the vision, designed to inspire global participation, nurture revival and build Christ centered transformation in every sphere of life

1. SALVATION RUN EVENTS Run the race with endurance Hebrews 12:1

- Annual or bi-annual symbolic marathons are held in major cities across continents.
- Combines prayer walks, worship sessions, evangelistic outreach, and citywide witness.
- Includes virtual participation, enabling a truly global spiritual movement.

2. YOUTH REVIVAL CAMPS In the last days, I will pour out My Spirit on all flesh Acts 2:17

- Spirit-led camps focused on reviving the next generation through sport, healthy lifestyle initiatives, worship, teaching, deliverance, and impartation.
- Equips youth to become Christ-anchored leaders, Ambassadors for Christ revivalists, and culture shapers in their nations.
- Designed for deep encounters with God and life-transforming discipleship.

3. KINGDOM AMBASSADORS TRAINING We are therefore Christ's ambassadors 2 Corinthians 5:20

- Empowering youth and lay leaders to be salt and light in strategic areas of society Media, Governance, Education, Business, and Technology. Workshops, certifications, and mentorship to shape Kingdom-minded professionals. Promotes biblical worldview leadership in secular environments.



4. MEDIA OUTREACH INITIATIVES Proclaim it from the rooftops Matthew 10:27

- Creation of short films, podcasts, music, testimonies, and social media content to reach the digital generation.
- Evangelistic storytelling that is relevant, creative, and Spirit-filled.
- Collaborations with Christian creatives, influencers, and digital missionaries.

5. MERCY MISSIONS Whatever you did for the least of these you did for Me. Matthew 25:40

- Sports for peace, and community wellness initiatives in underserved regions. Organizing medical camps, disaster response, Demonstrating the love of Christ through compassionate action and holistic care.
- Strategic partnerships with Christian hospitals, humanitarian organizations, and local churches.





SALVATION RUN ORGANIZATIONAL FRAMEWORK & GOVERNANCE MODEL

Let all things be done decently and in order. **1 Corinthians 14:40**

I. GLOBAL COUNCIL OF ELDERS

Function: Apostolic and prophetic oversight; spiritual alignment across denominations and nations. Composed of senior leaders from various Christian traditions. Providing spiritual guidance, accountability, biblical soundness, and unity. Oversees doctrine, intercession strategy, and covenant partnerships.

II. EXECUTIVE LEADERSHIP TEAM (CORE SENATE)

Function: Strategic leadership and operational execution. Led by a Global Director/President and core regional coordinators. Manages project development, budgets, communication, and partnerships. Coordinates between continents, ensuring cultural relevance and global consistency.


III. NATIONAL/REGIONAL COORDINATION TEAMS

Function: Local leadership and movement expansion. Each country/region has a National Coordinator and working committee. Adapts global vision to national context (e.g., language, culture, laws). Mobilizes churches, youth, institutions, and volunteers.

IV. MINISTRY DEPARTMENTS / STRATEGIC WINGS

Each core pillar of Salvation Run is managed by a dedicated department

- **Unity & Church Relations:** Denominational partnerships, interchurch collaboration
- **Youth & Discipleship:** Camps, training, mentorship, events
- **Prayer & Intercession:** 24/7 prayer chains, worship events, prophetic run
- **Media & Creative:** Content creation, outreach campaigns, digital evangelism
- **Social Reformation & Mercy Missions:** Community impact, medical aid, justice initiatives
- **Administration & Finance:** Governance, legal, fundraising, reporting



V. KINGDOM AMBASSADOR NETWORK (VOLUNTEER FORCE)

Roles include evangelists, worship leaders, intercessors, media agents, and social reformers. Supported through ongoing training, digital toolkits, and accountability structures.

VI. ADVISORY BOARD

Function: Guidance from experts in law, media, finance, youth development, education, healthcare, etc. Assists with compliance, best practices, partnerships, and impact measurement. Includes both Christian professionals and non-denominational kingdom allies.


VII. GOVERNANCE VALUES

What is Inter-Denominational Christianity?

Why is Inter-Denominational Unity Vital Today? "May they be brought to complete unity to let the world know that you sent me..." John 17:23



How Does Salvation Run Promote Inter-Denominationalism?

- **Neutral and Christ-Centered Language** The movement avoids denominational branding, using inclusive, biblically grounded terminology and practices that welcome all Christ-followers.
- **Cross-Denominational Leadership Council** the Senate and local coordination teams intentionally include clergy and lay leaders from diverse Christian traditions, ensuring shared ownership.
- **Shared Platforms and Pulpits** All events from prayer rallies to evangelistic runs feature diverse spiritual expressions, music styles, and preaching voices, celebrating the rich tapestry of the global Church.
- **Training for Respectful Engagement** Participants are trained to approach differences with humility, engage in dialogue, and focus on common ground rather than doctrinal contention.
- **Partnerships, Not Proselytism** Salvation Run does not seek to convert believers from one denomination to another, but to inspire all to deeper faith and active discipleship within their own traditions.
- **Ecumenical Prayer & Worship** Inter-denominational prayer gatherings are held in churches, homes, and public spaces emphasizing unity in the Spirit over uniformity in form.
